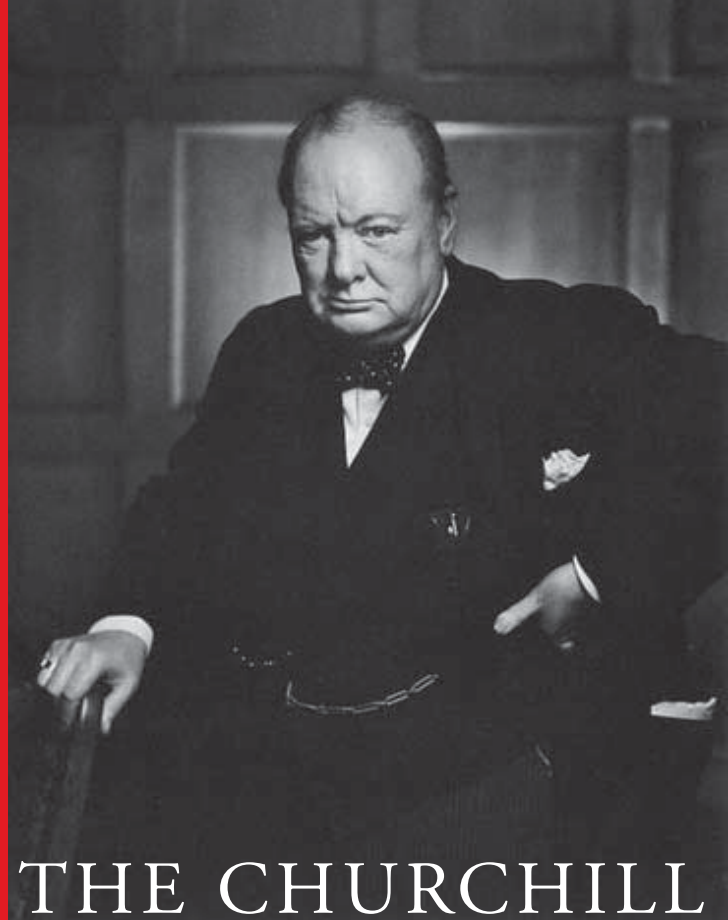


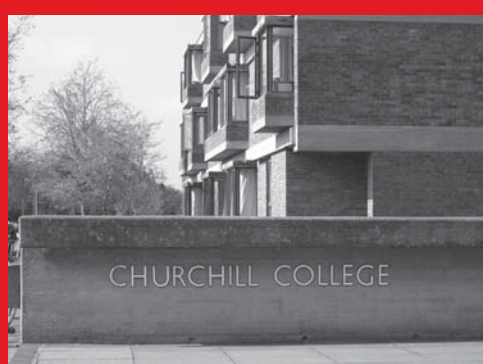

THE CHURCHILL SCHOLARSHIP

Sciences Engineering Mathematics

The Winston Churchill Foundation of the United States awards fourteen Churchill Scholarships for one year of postgraduate research and study at the University of Cambridge.



Named in honor of Sir Winston Churchill, the Churchill Scholarship is a one-year award that leads to the Master of Philosophy in the many areas of the Biological Sciences, the Physical Sciences, and Engineering or to the Master of Advanced Study in Pure Mathematics or Applied Mathematics and Theoretical Physics from the University of Cambridge. Churchill Scholars reside in Churchill College.

The criteria for the selection of include:

- Exceptional academic achievement
- A record of advanced research and study
- Awards, honors, and prizes
- Outstanding personal qualities

The Churchill Scholarship pays all University and College fees (approximately £15,000), provides a living allowance of £10,000 (for a nine-month program) or £12,000 (for a twelve-month program), and reimburses travel costs to and from the United Kingdom up to \$1,000. The Churchill Foundation also offers a Special Research Grant of up to \$2,000. (The total value of the Scholarship varies in accordance with the exchange rate.)

Applicants for the Churchill Scholarship must be citizens of the United States who are enrolled in or have recently graduated from one of the colleges or universities participating in the Scholarship Program. The next deadlines for the submission of applications are:

- November 9, 2010
- November 8, 2011
- November 13, 2012
- November 12, 2013
- November 11, 2014

Please note that each participating campus has its own, earlier deadline for the review and nomination of applicants for the Churchill Scholarship.
